Dobšiná Ice Cave




Dobšiná Ice Cave is located near the mining town of <u>Dobšiná</u> in the <u>Slovak Paradise.</u> Since 2000 it has been included on the <u>UNESCO</u> <u>World Heritage</u> list as a part of the Caves of Aggtelek Karst and Slovak Karst Site

• HISTORY

The cave was discovered on **15 June 1870** by the royal mining engineer <u>Jenő Ruffinyi</u>. In **1887**, it was the first electically lit cave in Europe.

In **1890** a concert was held in the Great Hall (one of the halls of the cave) in honor of <u>Charles Louis Habsburg</u> and in year **1893** the first summer skating took place in here.



DESCRIPTION

Entrance to the cave lies at an altitude of **970 m**. above sea level, which is about 130 meters above the river **Hnilec**. Of the total lenght of **1483m**, a **515m** long circuit is open to the public.

<u>Dobšiná Ice Cave</u> is a type of **static-dynamic cave**. Due to the high position of the entrance and the baggy character, a special **air circulation**_is created in the winter. A cold air penetrates from the surface into the ground and, as heavier, pushes warm lighter air and at the same time cools the air walls. The seeping water froze, forming **ice scalactites**, **stalagmites**, **ice falls and floor ice**.



Thickness of the floor ice: 25m

- Area: 11 200m2
- Volume of ice: 145 000m3
- Temperature: -3,9C -0,2C
